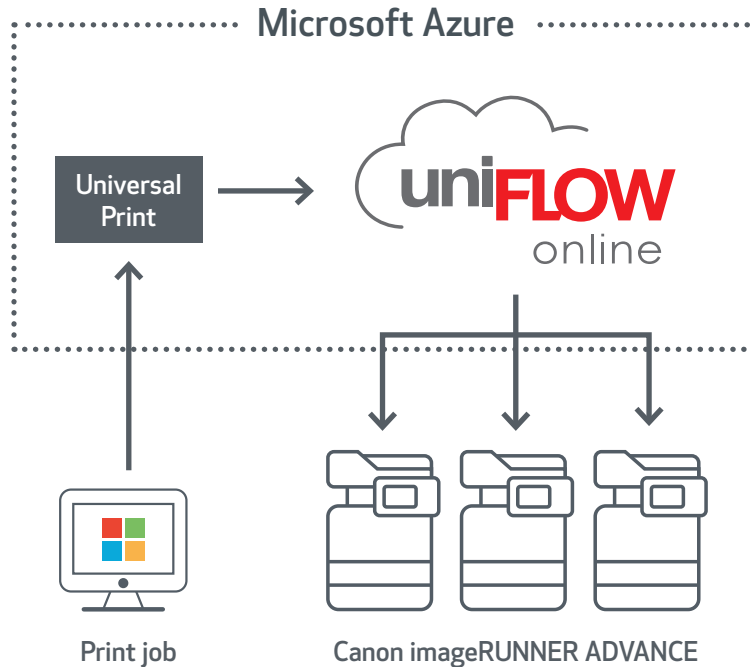

Universal Print, developed by Microsoft®, provides a simple and efficient method to securely submit a print job. Its native integration helps support a seamless experience for administrators and users.



uniFLOW Online integrated with Microsoft Universal Print combines powerful features with straightforward administration. Universal Print is responsible for the end user's printing experience, from connecting to the shared queue in Microsoft Azure™ to the "file print" action in the application. uniFLOW Online further extends the capabilities by offering additional functionalities to the print environment including:

- Secure Printing with a single universal queue.
- My Print Anywhere to allow users to release their job to any device, including those not supporting Universal Print natively.
- Full accounting (print, copy, fax, scan), prices, cost centers, and reporting.
- Support for other client operating systems such as Mac® and ChromeOS™.
- Mobile Printing and Mobile Printing for guests.
- And much more!

uniFLOW Online is a 100 percent cloud solution that connects natively to Universal Print. No servers, services, hubs, connectors, or client software are required when Universal Print is combined with uniFLOW Online and imageRUNNER ADVANCE devices. uniFLOW Online registers itself as a single print queue in Universal Print, allowing users to use any printer in their organization to release the job. Users can select advanced finishing options such as duplex, color mode, hole-punch, stapling, eco stapling, copy count, or paper catalog from the Windows print dialog or the printer panel.



INTEGRATE WITH EVEN MORE MICROSOFT APPLICATIONS

uniFLOW Online supports claims-based authentication against multiple identity providers, e.g. Microsoft Office 365™ or on-premise Windows Active Directory®. It is also listed in the Microsoft Azure App Gallery, allowing administrators to use even more pre-configured claim action mappings for Azure AD and Office 365™. Administrators benefit from a simple set-up process and easy user management.

Changes to documents saved in cloud storage services are immediately visible and accessible by co-workers, making collaboration easy and effective. Users can print their documents directly, while standing at the multifunction device (MFD), from a range of the most popular cloud services including Microsoft OneDrive®.

With uniFLOW Online, users can scan documents directly to their preferred scanning destination, e.g. Microsoft OneDrive®, Microsoft OneDrive® for Business, and Microsoft SharePoint® Online. The lean and intuitive user interface of the workflows supports gains in productivity.

UNLEASH THE FULL POWER WITH CANON DEVICES

By combining imageRUNNER ADVANCE devices with uniFLOW Online, organizations can support user authentication at the device before releasing their jobs. In addition, certain device functionalities, e.g. printing or copying in color, can be restricted based on user rights. uniFLOW Online also tracks the complete print, copy, fax, and scan usage of the Canon device so costs can be correctly charged back to users, departments, or cost centers. This powerful combination also allows the user to print from and scan to cloud-based document management systems such as OneDrive and SharePoint Online.
